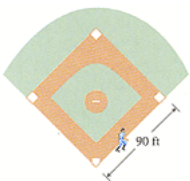
STOP THE BLEED

Friday, July 11, 2025, from 1:00pm – 3:00pm the Dane County Sheriff's Office will be hosting STOP THE BLEED, a free hands-on training where attendees will learn the basic blood control principles to help prevent major blood loss for an injured person while waiting for EMS to arrive. BALL DIAMONDS IN THE VILLAGE PARKS

If you are caught vandalizing the ball diamonds, citations will be issued. Please respect the ball diamonds and fields. Parents, please help to educate your children regarding the importance of not using ball diamonds as a play area.

PICK UP DOG WASTE IN THE PARKS AND PUBLIC AREAS

Reminder to all dog owners that all dog poop **MUST** be picked up at all parks and public areas and properly disposed of. The amount of poop in the parks is ALARMING. If the issue continues, measures will be taken to ban dogs from the parks within the Village of Dane.

PICKLEBALL AND MULTISPORTS COURTS

The Pickleball and multisport courts at Capitol Valley Park are closed until all footing, painting, and construction plans are completed. Please stay off the courts during this time to ensure that the finishing touches are completed properly. A ribbon cutting ceremony and official openings will be posted on the website when the courts are ready for use. **Reminder** – the courts are for designated sport use only, rubber soled shoes required, no wheels (skateboards, rollerblades, bikes, scooters, etc.) are allowed, no pets, no food or glass on the courts. Rules will be posted; violators may receive citations.

BOOKMOBILE AND SUMMER CRAFTS

BURNING ENDS MAY 15, 2025
