FALL BURNING BEGINS ON OCTOBER 1




Leaves, grass, and garden waste can be burned beginning October 1 through November 15 each year. According to village ordinances, burning can be done from 6 pm - 6 am

Monday through Saturday. Burning is never allowed on Sundays. All burning needs to be done in a safe manner and no fires should be left unattended at any time.

COMMUNITY CATS CAUSING PROBLEMS

The Village Clerk's Office and the Dane County Sheriff's Deputy have received several complaints regarding the feeding

of "outdoor community cats." Village ordinance 197-6 clearly states: keeping dogs, cats, fowl, and other animals at large within the limits of the village is



restricted. Chapter 197-10 covers property damage caused by animals at large. Fines start at \$500, if you are cited for allowing community cats to shelter on your property. If you are in the habit of feeding and allowing community cats to run at large on your property, you are encouraged to stop immediately. Further complaints will result in citations.

ATV"S & UTV's

A local group has approached the Village Trustees about the use of ATV's and UTV's on village streets. A Plan Commission meeting will be held in September where public input can be given. Watch for more information to come.
