



Q2 What size is your current residence?





Q3 How much do you spend on housing costs (mortgage/rent plus utilities) per month?





Q7 If you were to move in the next 5 years, are you likely to stay within the Village of Dane?



Q11 Indicate your support for public investment in the following transportation options in the Village of Dane?








Q14 How would you describe the availability of employment opportunities in the Village of Dane?



Q18 How close is the nearest park or trail to your home?







Q20 How often do you visit the Village's parks?






